


## Saturday Sampler-Block 16

## Sweet Sixteen

Block finishes 6" square (6½ unfinished)

This block likely got its name because there are sixteen pieces in the block! It is a pretty block made in two colors with simple squares and rectangles.





## What you need:

Fabric 1(white): two  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (1), four  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (2), and two  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (3) Fabric 2 (coral): two  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (4) four  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (5), and two  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (6)

## Sew it together:

- 1. Sew the Fabric 1 and Fabric 2 rectangles together in pairs (fig. 1)
- 2. Sew the 11/2" squares together to make a four-patch (fig. 2).
- 3. Lay out the block as shown in the diagram below and sew together. The block should measure 6½" square at this point.





This block makes a lovely two-color quilt. It is also a great block for using scraps. It makes a very pretty scrap quilt!


