

Scrap-Basket Surprise Jelly Roll 16-Patch



- 1 Jelly Roll (40 strips of 2-1/2" wide fabric)
- 2 yards setting fabric
- 3/4 yard inner border fabric
- 2 yards outer border fabric
- 3/4 yard binding fabric
- 4-1/2 yards backing fabric

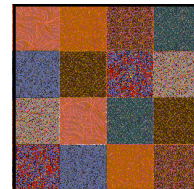
I pieced the 16-patch blocks with squares. If you want to strip piece these blocks, don't cut squares from the jelly roll strips.

Cutting:

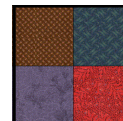
- Cut 656 2-1/2" squares from jelly roll strips
Note: I got 17 squares from each strip. If you only get 16 squares from your strips, cut an extra 2-1/2" strip from the outer border fabric in order to get enough squares.
- From setting fabric:
 - cut three 4-1/2" strips; sub-cut into 48 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles
 - cut three 8-1/2" strips; sub-cut into 48 8-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles
 - Cut two 12-5/8" strips; sub-cut into 5 12-5/8" squares. Cut each of these on the diagonal twice for setting triangles.
 - From the remaining 12-5/8" squares, cut two 6-3/4" squares. Cut both on the diagonal twice for corner triangles.

Piecing:

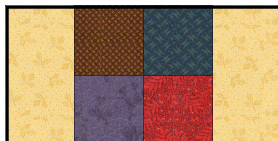
16-Patch Blocks: Make 35
Use an assortment of 16 2-1/2" squares for each block



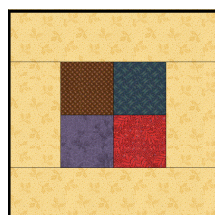
Alternate block: Make 24
Using the remaining 2-1/2" squares, make 24 four-patch blocks



Sew 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles of setting fabric on opposite sides of each four-patch block. Press toward setting fabric.



Sew 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles of setting fabric on top and bottom of block. Press toward setting fabric.



Sew blocks together in an on-point setting.

Borders: Cut 8 2-1/2" strips for inner border
Cut 9-6-1/2" strips for outer border

Sew borders to quilt top, quilt and bind.
Quilt finishes about 72" x 96"



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
