



Saturday Sampler-Block 1

Sew Simple

Block finishes 6" square

One of my very first quilts was made from this block. It was the sweetest little baby quilt! I'm sure you will like making it, whether you make one block or a whole quilt from these blocks. This is a great block for scraps.



What you need:

Fabric 1 (blue): one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square

Fabric 2 (gold): one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square

Fabric 3 (white): three $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Sew it together:

Row 1: sew a white square to the blue rectangle

Row 2: sew a blue, white, and gold square together with the white in the center

Row 3: sew a white square to the gold rectangle

Sew the rows together as shown in the diagram. You can either press seams away from the white, or press them open.

Here are a few layout options if you want to make a whole quilt from these blocks.
